## Trash/Recycling Policy & Guidelines

---

**Trash Provider:** Savage Sanitation

Please see the policy and guidelines below for use of trash and recycling, disposal of, and helpful information.

American Pride will retrieve/and replace all trash and recycling cans in the outside, latched store sheds on collection days.

Do not remove trash and/or recycling cans from the storage sheds placing them on a sidewalk or driveway.

Do not place bagged trash or recyclables on the floor of the storage shed.

**Rental Property Owners: Post these guidelines in your rental villa.**

### **HOUSEHOLD TRASH**

**Picked up Saturday and Wednesday.**

Keep all household trash containers on the outside, latched storage sheds located on the outside of each villa.

Household trash cans must be covered with lids provided (by the villa owner). This also helps to mitigate wildlife, rodent and pest issues.

Owners and guests must place the trash in the containers by 7am, preferably the night before.

All household trash must be bagged and tied, and placed in designated trash receptacles and covered with secured lids that are located in the outside storage shed.

**Note:** Pizza Boxes and Styrofoam are Trash.

### **RECYCLING**

**Picked up on Saturday only.**

Do not bag recyclable items.

Rinse all items before disposing in an appropriately marked recycling container also located in the outside storage shed.

Recyclable items not properly cleaned will be designated as household trash when pickup occurs.

Place the recyclable materials in the outside storage shed in the appropriately marked container by 7:00 AM on Saturday, preferably the night before.

***If your guests miss trash/recycling pickup day/time upon their departure, your cleaning company will be responsible for disposing all household trash and recycling offsite. Please notify your rental management company and cleaning personnel of this policy. The villa owner will absorb any fees incurred.***

### **ACCEPTABLE RECYCLE**

Aluminum cans  
Brown paper bags  
Cardboard (cut down and taped)  
Catalogs, magazines and phone books  
Chipboard (cereal and shoe boxes)  
Colored paper  
Envelopes  
Glass bottles and jars  
Newspapers and junk mail  
Plastic bottles and jugs  
Tin and steel cans  
White ledger paper

### **NON-RECYCLABLE**

Auto glass or ceramics  
Batteries  
Film canisters  
Light bulbs  
Painted wood  
Plastic grocery bags (take back to store)  
Plastic wrap  
Porcelaine  
Styrofoam  
Treated wood

## **HELPFUL INFORMATION**

- One decal per homeowner/no charge for the decal
- Three (3) visits per week
- The Convenience Center's personnel are extremely helpful

### **WHAT IS ACCEPTED?**

- Bagged household trash (garbage)
- Bulky items: furniture, toys and bulky household items
- Clear glass, brown glass and green glass
- Aluminum and steel cans
- Plastic 1 and 2 (sodas, water bottles, milk jugs, detergent bottles, etc.)
- Newspapers, magazines, cardboard, white office paper, pasteboard and mixed paper
- Tires, batteries, oil and appliances
